Town Board Representative: Bill Willis: Cemetery Issue: McKinstry burial is in the wrong location at Riverside Cemetery. Jessy will touch base with McKinstry indicting the incorrect burial placement. Fencing Town Garage & Dump: Fred will reach out to VT Solid Surfacing for a revised quote.

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**Color Printer:** Bill made the motion to approve the purchase of an HP Color Printer for the Town Clerk's Office. Gary seconded the motion. All approved.

**Other:** Various Waterford residents and visitors have complained of trash along the waterside at the bottom of Maple Street. Jessy will notify Great River Hydro of the issue.

**Executive Session:** Selectmen went into executive session at 9:15pm and came out at 9:19pm. Gary will work up a draft for a comp. time policy.
