## TOWN OF WATERFORD ROAD POLICY Classes 2-3-4

## ALL ROADS

- Any work in the road right-of-way, ei. logging, digging, etc, must have the permission of the selectmen or their agent.
- 2. All driveways must have a permit.
- 3. Snow can not be plowed across the road. State Law
- 4. Over weight permits are required by State Law.
- 5. No blocking of the road in any way.
- 6. Permanent fences can not be built in the road right-of-way (49'6" wide or 24'9" from center).

## CLASS 4 ROADS

- 1. The town has to maintain culverts and bridges of Class 4 roads so that they are safe, or remove them.
- 2. The town doesn't have to plow, grade or maintain them in any other way.
- 3. If anyone builds on a Class 4 road, they must maintain the road. If the road is upgraded, it will be at the land owner's expense and may not be reclassified or maintained by the town.
- 4. Before a road will be considered to be reclassified it must be built up to Class 3 standards by the land owner and it should produce enough town tax to pay for maintenance and upkeep.
- 5. The town crew will not work for hire on any Class IV roads, ei. plowing, grading, or sanding.
