How Does A Student Enroll?

Enrollment packets may be picked up at the School Office beginning on April 1. Packets should be returned on or before Memorial Day with a \$100 registration fee.

Students enrolling in the K4 program must turn four on or before January 1. Students enrolling in the K5 program must turn five on or before January 1. Entrance tests will be scheduled for all incoming students, in grades 1-12.

When Does School Begin?

KICK-OFF for <u>ALL GRADES</u> is in August. See Student Packet for the exact date. The first day of school is the day following KICK-OFF.

What Is The Cost?

The tuition for each child is figured on a 10-period payment plan. The first payment is due by September 7th. Subsequent tuition payments are due on the seventh of each <u>month</u>. Example tuition rates per pay period are as follows:
