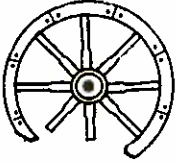


The Council reconvened into open session.
