After speaking with the reps from both companies, Alejandro and I feel strongly we should go with CCS as our consulting firm for the feasibility Study.

They lower their proposal by \$1000. See enclosed proposal and replace the old one. We also found that their proposal includes more services for the money and their commitment to our success seems stronger. If they are to do our campaign, their consulting services are the same cost as Greater Mission, but their expertise, team involvement, resources and commitment will be available for us for the 5 year project, at the same cost. Greater Mission would charge us extra for follow-up services.
