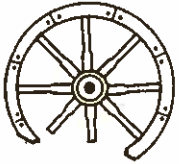

No.2021-11 To advertise for bids on wrecked police vehicles advertise for bids will be placed in the newspaper.


