COVID-19 Parent Agreement

I am aware that my actions as a parent or legal guardian will impact the safety of others in the PDGA gymnastics and diving facility. Pacific Diving Academy and Straight A's Gymnastics Academy (SAGA) are counting on me and all the other parents and kids to help keep us all safe by meeting the physicaldistancing and personal hygiene standards recommended by the CDC and the State of California.

While parents are always able to watch, PDA/SAGA will need to limit in-person viewing because our viewing area will hold 75% fewer spectators if we are to conform to the 6-ft social distancing standards. To compensate we will provide online viewing of your child's group in the gym through Spot TV or our current camera system. More details to follow.

As a consequence of the restrictions placed on PDA/SAGA by the California Department of Health and our commitment to safety, parents must agree to follow to the following policies:

- Students must use the restroom and wash their hands thoroughly <u>before</u> leaving for the gym. Students should always wash both hands and feet after returning home. Hand sanitizer will be provided throughout the gym and waiting areas. Students should use hand sanitizer before and after class.
- 2. Only <u>one</u> parent may enter the gym with their child. Only children attending class may enter. Parents are welcome to drop off and pickup in front of the gym. PDGA Staff will look after the students outside in good weather.
- 3. All adults entering PDGA <u>must</u> wear a facemask. Parents not wearing a face mask will not be allowed to enter the facility. Children are welcome to wear masks too, even in class.
- PDGA will have only one entrance and one exit. Once you step past the red lines in the lobby area, you <u>will not</u> be allowed to go back. You must exit the gym through the designated exit. Once you exit the gym, you will not be allowed to re-enter.
- 5. The lobby and entry area will not include seating and will have clearly marked physicaldistancing position indicators. If this space starts to fill up kindly move to the viewing area or wait outside and we will walk your child out to meet you.
- 6. Please do not send your sick child or yourself into the gym if you are not feeling well. We offer unlimited make-ups.
- 7. If all viewing space is taken, no further seating will be possible and waiting parents will need to wait outside.

I will do my part to help make the PDGA safe by being respectful of the gym's social-distancing policies, insisting that my child wash their hands before entering the gym and when arriving at home, and by supporting the amazing coaches and staff as they work hard to provide a safe place to develop Happy, Healthy and Confident Kids.
