Dear Church Family,

Far too often, I think, we miss the impact of a good story. Stories have the power to lift us up, challenge our thoughts, and transform us within. Particularly, the stories that remind us of who we are and where we have come from are especially powerful.

In the Psalms the author speaks of the importance of telling the stories of the great things God has done so that future generations may hear of the goodness of God.

The truth is, our world around us is filled with stories that bring us down. Stories about pain, violence, and controversy surround us each day. Listening to those stories can sometimes make us feel that there is no hope, peace, or mercy in the world.

I believe that is why it is so important for us to speak the truth of God's story into the lives of everyone around us. By sharing the story of who God is and what God has done, we are able to pierce through the darkness of our world and remind them that there is something and someone greater that calls us to a new reality.

This fall we have some great opportunities to recall the stories of the Bible and remember who we are as the beloved sons and daughters of God.

Beginning on September 8th at 9am, we have 11 youth who are going through confirmation where they will learn about who God is and how they relate as descendants in the family of God. We will also have a Bible Study class that will look at covenants that God has made with people throughout the old and new testaments that tell of how the story of God has been told over the ages. There will also be a current issues class called "The Wired Word" where we can talk about the stories of current events in light of the way we are called to live in scripture. Our young adults will also have a chance to participate in their own class where they can share in the stories of their lives, raising kids, starting a career, and finding their own identity.

In worship I will be starting a sermon series for the fall called "The Story of Us" where we will look at important stories of the Old Testament that have shaped and defined the people of God. I hope you will take advantage of some of these, and other incredible opportunities at Forest Hills this fall as we continue to search for the will of God in the story of our lives.






Womens Walk #140

AUGUST SESSION NOTES

Our session is made up of representatives of the congregation who serve in 3 year terms as elders of the church and serve on committees. Session notes are provided in the monthly newsletter to inform the congregation about major items discussed or decisions made.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE

The oak trees by the Maples house have contracted oak wilt, 2 have died and need to be taken down and the remaining 10 are being treated to prevent the spread of the disease. Strata Roofing has been paid from McBride Construction and the lawyer will be filing a motion to dismiss the lawsuit against the church. The Living Temples initiative is interested in exploring a potential walking trail in the field behind the CWNC.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The committee is looking at how to address growing children in the Sunday worship service. Volunteers are needed to help with children's church and a new rug is needed for the Matthew Mat. 50 children attended VBS this year and follow up has been well received. Confirmation classes start on September 8th, 11 students will be going through the process this fall. There will be 3 adult educational offerings for the Sunday School hour this fall, as well as the confirmation meetings each Sunday Morning.

MISSION & OUTREACH COMMITTEE

Missions Sunday will be coming up in September, the committee is exploring ways to connect with the local community. Forest Hills has been represented well in the city this summer with the Shop With A Cop event with Helotes PD and FD and the Helotes Movie Night series at city hall. The committee is looking into how to make the items in the blessing bags more useful.

WORSHIP COMMITTEE

The committee has analyzed attendance trends over the past 3 years and made recommendations regarding increased attendance. Pastor Reuben is going to switch to the narrative lectionary to hit the high point stories of the Old Testament through the fall. The committee is looking at addressing tech concerns with slides and videos for the worship services.

FELLOWSHIP & CHURCH GROWTH COMMITTEE

The fellowship committee is considering moving fellowship hour into the CWNC to accommodate more people as it is outgrowing the narthex. The committee needs volunteers to help set up and tear down at fellowship events and lunches.
