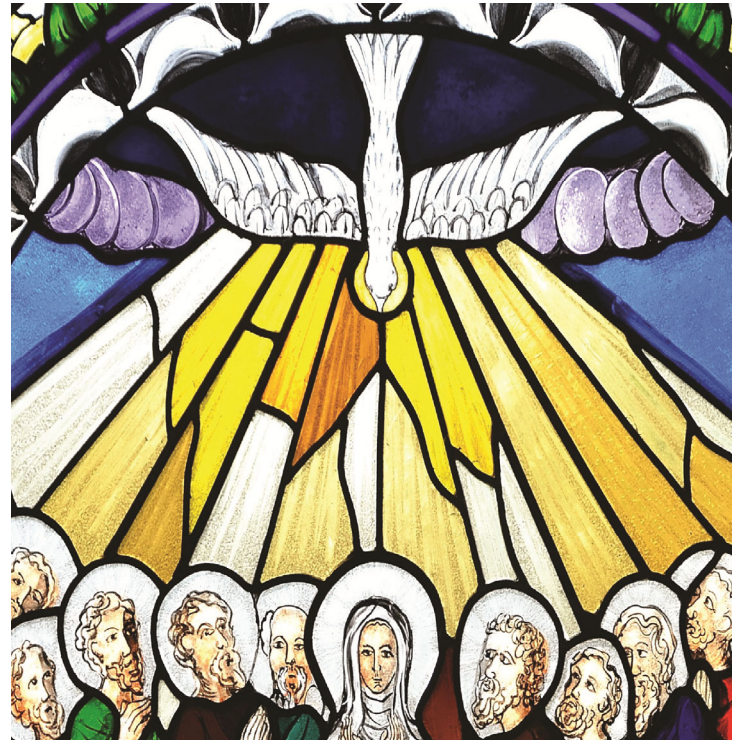

**Pentecost** when the seven weeks of Easter had come to an end, Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, manifested given and communicated as a divine person; of his fullness, Christ, the Lord, pours out the Spirit in abundance. CCC 731

**The Blessed Virgin Mary** her Motherhood for the Church, her spiritual offspring, is revealed at the foot of the cross. There, where her divine Son, the Church's head, suffers death, she takes John - and with him, all of us - as her children: "Woman, behold your son." She again obeys the Word to whom she gave herself completely at the Annunciation. In clinging to her like little children, we are all the more conformed to Jesus and thus made worthy to inherit his Kingdom. Magnificat

**Saint Ephrem** was a Syrian theologian and poet who authored biblical commentaries, homilies, and composed many hymns still used today by the Syriac liturgy; he is known as the "Harp of the Holy Spirit"; he died in 373.

**Saint Barnabas** While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." Acts 13:2 Thus began the great mission to the Gentiles; he died sometime before the year 63.

**Gospel** — Jesus Christ appears to the disciples and sends them on their mission with the power to forgive or retain sins through the Holy Spirit (John 20:19-23) or John 14:15-16, 23b-26.

**Brothers and Sisters,**

The readings in today's liturgy help us understand the role of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Church: (1) The Holy Spirit helps us widen the scope of our mission, (2) The Holy Spirit strengthens the Church with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and (3) The Holy Spirit enriches the Church with the fruits of the Holy Spirit.



The Holy Spirit is our breath. God breathes new life into us by sending us the Holy Spirit. We are created anew and together with God we work to renew the face of the earth. Today we complete the fifty-day celebration of Easter with the feast of Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. As the world was transformed when Christ was born, making God incarnate in our world, the world is once more transformed with God's gift of the Holy Spirit to all who are baptized, making God present continuously and forever in our world.

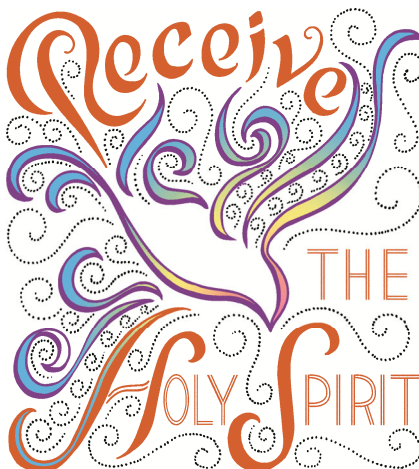
There is a fairly recent craze known as photo-bombing in which a person tries to get into someone else's photograph. With so many people having mobile phones that take pictures of family and friends, photo-bombing is easy enough to do. It may even happen accidentally. However, the practice is not entirely a new practice. It is well-known that Renaissance artists like to include themselves in paintings of religious subjects. One such artist was a Greek painter and sculptor of the Spanish Renaissance known as "El Greco." One of his over 200 works of art was an enormously tall canvas depicting the day of Pentecost and the artist placed himself in the same locked room with the disciples. El Greco depicts the scene as we have heard it today in our readings, with tongues of fire coming to rest on the heads of the disciples. And there was El Greco, gazing out of the picture quite unapologetically, as if to be saying, "Here I am, celebrating this giant birthday of the Church with all these holy men and women." He understood that the coming of the Holy Spirit was no private affair. Pentecost was and is a celebration of diversity and inclusivity such as the world had never known. Today's gospel makes it clear that anyone who loves Jesus is beloved of God: God will come to that person and make a home with them.

The life of heaven continues to transform ordinary people like us into spiritual beings. St. Paul reminds us that we are part of God's family, privileged to address God as "Abba", our Father. The Spirit moves us in a different direction, stretching us beyond our self-absorption as we allow Jesus to live out his own life within us. We may never hear the sound of a strong driving wind, nor feel tongues of fire rest upon our heads, but we can be sure that God has made a home with us, a forever home.

Today our Jewish brothers and sisters celebrate "Shavuot", the Feast of Weeks commemorating the day God gave the Torah to Moses on Mount Sinai and the Jewish community became a nation dedicated to serving God. In return God promised an enduring presence in their lives. God's enduring presence in the lives of humanity is highly valued by people of all faiths. We too celebrate God's enduring presence, we do so in the person of the Holy Spirit who guides us, comforts us, advocates for us and gives us peace.

**THE SPIRIT'S ACTIVE POWER**

The mystery of the Trinity refers to one God in three persons. We frequently acknowledge Jesus as "the second person of the Trinity," but referring also to the Spirit as a "person" comes less naturally. In religious art, the Holy Spirit often appears as a dove or, as in today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, tongues of fire. Much rarer are images of the Spirit as a "person" in recognizable human form. Today's readings do not settle the issue of how to picture the Spirit, but they certainly give shape to the Spirit's active power in the world and in each human heart. In Acts, the Spirit enables people to speak and understand a variety of languages. Paul's letter to the Corinthians praises the Spirit for all kinds of spiritual gifts, services, and "workings." Finally, in John's Gospel, Jesus calls the Spirit our Advocate and our divine teacher.

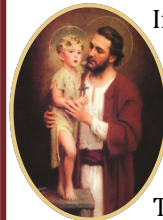

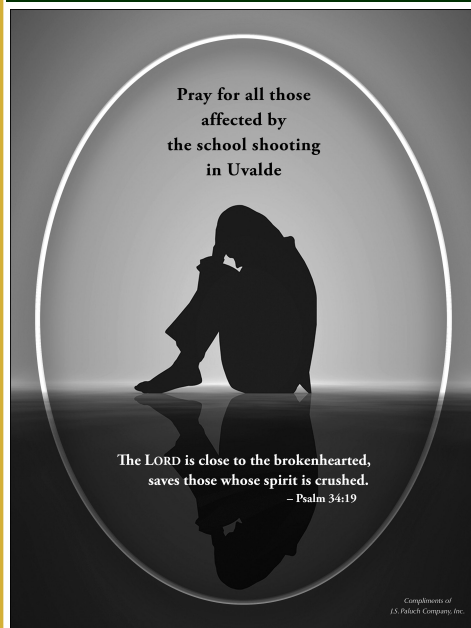

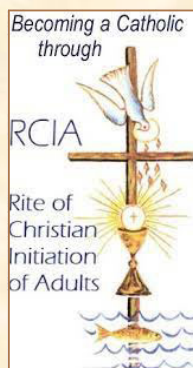

## LA OBRA CONTINUA DE DIOS

En el Evangelio de hoy, Lucas, el autor de los Hechos, relaciona el "tiempo de Pentecostés" con la fiesta judía de las Semanas. Esta era una fiesta de la cosecha, cincuenta días después de la Pascua. La fiesta se convirtió en una celebración del regalo de Dios de la Torá, la ley de Moisés, recordando Éxodo 19. Lucas sugiere que, al igual que la Fiesta de las Semanas era una culminación de la Pascua, la efusión del Espíritu Santo era una culminación de la Resurrección. Tanto en la Pascua como en la Pascua, la extraordinaria acción salvadora de Dios rescató al pueblo de Dios de la opresión y la muerte. Gracias a estas acciones, se preparó el escenario para el don de la Torá, y de forma similar para los cristianos, el don del Espíritu. La presencia continua del Espíritu nos sostiene para afrontar las cargas de la vida con gracia. El Espíritu también nos desafía cada día a madurar en nuestra capacidad de amar y a participar en la obra continua de Dios para rescatar a todo el pueblo de Dios.

## LO QUE DIOS ESTÁ HACIENDO

La comunidad cristiana reunida en el Cenáculo, a la espera del Espíritu Santo, ha suscitado durante mucho tiempo la imaginación cristiana. En nuestro tiempo, cuando la Iglesia tiene una larga historia de fe cristiana, pero ahora se enfrenta a muchos desafíos, podríamos volver a esta imagen. Como los primeros discípulos, a menudo no sabemos qué hacer a continuación. Lo que solía funcionar para nosotros ya no funciona tan bien. Tenemos que permanecer juntos, honrar la diversidad, reflexionar sobre las raíces de nuestra fe y permanecer arraigados en la oración.

Pero hay más. Pentecostés ha ocurrido y está ocurriendo. El Espíritu ya ha irrumpido en el mundo, ya se agita entre los que están confundidos sobre Dios. El libro de los Hechos cuenta la historia de una Iglesia continuamente empujada por el Espíritu, para unirse a lo que Dios ya estaba haciendo en el mundo. También nosotros estamos invitados no sólo a recordar nuestra unidad y nuestras raíces, sino a prestar una gran atención a la forma en que el Espíritu está actuando en nuestras comunidades locales.

## VARIEDAD DE DONES

En la segunda lectura de hoy, san Pablo escribe a la Iglesia de Corinto, una comunidad que sufre tensiones y divisiones en torno a los dones espirituales. Pablo les recuerda que el Espíritu comparte una variedad de dones; ninguno es mejor que otro, y todos son necesarios para toda la Iglesia. El Espíritu se revela en la diversidad de dones que ofrecen los individuos y los distintos grupos. El Espíritu desea que la Iglesia viva como un todo interdependiente y cohesionado, como el Cuerpo de Cristo.

Una parroquia puede ser una asociación colegiada en la que los feligreses, el clero y el personal ministerial pueden compartir con confianza los dones de Dios. Se pueden honrar los dones de personas y grupos de diversos orígenes. Los dones que tienden a ser menos visibles, como los de las finanzas, la custodia o la administración, pueden celebrarse tanto como los de la predicación y la música. Que podamos notar la gracia de Dios en esta diversidad.

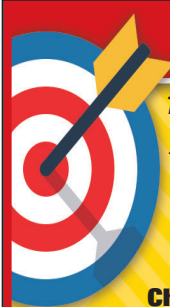
