Dear Friends,

Stephanie is doing very well and has completed all her therapy. Her speech is still a bit slurred, but she is making sentences, and she is very understandable. Tomorrow she will be undergoing minor surgery to put in an ICD (implantable cardioverter defibrillator and pacemaker). If all goes well, she will be able to travel to Moldova this summer and work in the camps. Pray with us that the surgery goes well and that the procedure normalizes her heart function.

I will be traveling to Moldova and Malawi in April and May. In April I will be in Moldova for a pastors' conference, summer camp planning, and staff training. In May I'll be traveling from Moldova to Malawi. The JohnMark Zeigler family will be arriving in March to begin their full-time ministry there. I will be teaching them aspects of the work, such as how to run medical clinics, and I'll be participating in our once-a-year founders conference for pastors. We are expecting over 200 pastors and their assistants at the two locations. I'm very excited to be returning to the work and will be cramming a lot into five weeks. Stephanie will be staying with my two daughters in Charlotte N.C. while I'm traveling. Please pray for the conferences in these two countries. If you have any mission funds available in your church for Pastor training, please consider helping us with these conferences. Thank you for your consideration.

We will be traveling to Moldova for summer camps in June. We are running 5 weeks of camp this year. The cost of running camps is going up as fuel and energy costs are increasing. Our supplement the cost of camp this year will be \$50 per camper, per week of camp. Please pray for the supply of the Lord.

Pray for the ministries as they are transitioning to new leadership. In Africa the Zeigler family is resuming the work and taking responsibility. In Moldova Timur Tricolici is assuming much of the responsibility in my absence.
