

# Being Misled!



*Nevada Secretary of State Barbara Cegavske has made it abundantly clear, since the beginning, that the all mail-in ballots were to be used for the Primary Election only.* In Nevada, absentee ballots have always been available; one simply requests that a ballot be sent to one's home. At the time the decision was made to do a mail-in Primary, little was known about the Covid-19 virus. All voting locations were going to be closed, as the overwhelming majority of volunteer poll workers were concerned and did not wish to assist. These and other factors led all 17 counties to request all mail-in ballots for the Primary Election.

The Secretary of State's office has had a lawsuit filed by the Nevada Democrat Party. They want mail-in ballots, ballot harvesting, and they do not want stringent verification of signatures.
