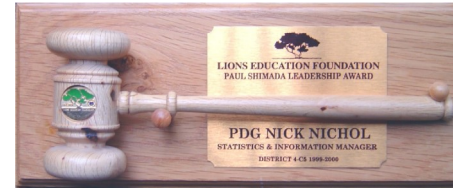

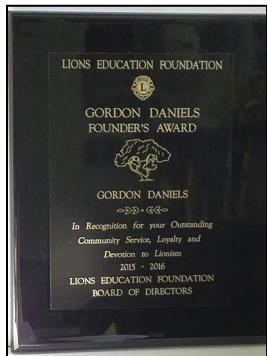
KAY K. FUKUSHIMA LIFE MEMBERSHIP
