WILDFIRE EVACUATION DRILL SCHEDULED FOR SUNDAY, JUNE 13th

The Shelter Cove Fire Department and Shelter Cove CERT are planning to hold the first ever Shelter Cove Wildfire Evacuation Practice Drill to be held on Sunday, June 13th at 12:00 noon. The Shelter Cove community is strongly encouraged to participate by evacuating to the Clubhouse area on Upper Pacific Drive when they hear the wildfire siren test at 12 noon on 06/13. The Fire Department and CERT will be evaluating the success of the drill by how well the sirens could be heard, how efficiently the flow of traffic occurred and how well the clubhouse worked as an evacuation site. Please let us know whether you were able to hear the siren by contacting the Fire Dept or making a note on your utility payment stub.

Chipper Days! The next three Chipper Days will start on Monday, June 21st and continue through Wednesday, June 23rd. Please pile your woody material on the roadside's edge with cut butts facing out. Please do not stack limbs over 5 ft high – just start a new pile. Tree trunks, stumps, rotten wood, rocks, and garbage cannot be chipped. Fire Extinguisher Recharge Reminder:

The community may bring their fire extinguishers to the Fire Station or District Office on the morning of Thursday, June 10th, for recharging by Eureka-Humboldt Fire Extinguisher. If you have any questions, please call (707) 822-2517. The cost of this service will depend on the unit size. One time use only extinguishers cannot be recharged.

ONLINE BILL PAYMENT NOW AVAILABLE

The District is partnering with Allpaid to enable online utility payments through: <https://allpaid.com/>

You can use this simple online method to pay your District utility bill. The cost (fee) of using this service is 2.25% per (self-pay) transaction. Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover Card credit and debit cards are accepted.

To make an online utility payment, go to <https://allpaid.com/> and enter *Resort Improvement District* in the search box below 'Make a Payment' and click 'Get Started.' You will confirm the payment selection (for Resort Improvement District) by clicking on 'Pay This Destination.'

To complete an online payment, you will need your utility account number (located on the top left, second line of your utility bill) and the service street address. The District's website will also link to Allpaid's website.

Firework Safety:

Please be extra safe with fireworks this year as we are experiencing very dry conditions. On Sunday, July 4th, the Fire Department will make a family/kids area available, adjacent the Clubhouse, for safe and sane fireworks. Activities will commence one-hour before sunset.

Closure of Burn Season Imminent:

The end of the burning season will soon be announced by the State. Once the closure is announced all burning must cease.

Water Conservation:

California and our North Coast region are currently in a state of drought. The District encourages the entire Shelter Cove community to reduce water use whenever they can.
