NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Council of the Village of Blacks Harbour, in compliance with Section 111 of the Community Planning Act of the Province of New Brunswick, intends to hold a Public Hearing of Objections and/or Comments for the proposed **Rural Plan By-law No. Z.2 on Wednesday May 18th, 2022, starting at 6:00 P.M.**

The proposed **Rural Plan By-law No. Z.2** is a by-law to re-adopt the current rural plan under the new *Community Planning Act, 2017, c.19*, consolidate past zoning changes, and introduce several amendments to the rural plan by-law. This by-law would revert a portion of land from Industrial (Ind) to Single & Two Family Residential (R-1) Zone and introduce a new multi-unit residential zone (R-3) as well as several other changes.
