Acts 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.

As the early church prayed, God worked, and gave them boldness and power for effective ministry. I know that many of you were praying for our mission trips this summer. Your prayers were answered and God used us to take the gospel to the lost. On the trip along the Amazon River in Brazil we were able to travel to four different villages. The president over each village gave us permission to come into his village and hold a medical clinic. Over 200 people were treated within a number of days. The medical care showed God's love to the Brazilian people and opened the door to hold a service in each village. During the services, testimonies were shared, songs were sung, and the gospel was preached. One night we saw two young men come to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior. As teams went out into homes in the villages sharing the gospel three others also accepted Christ. We also had the opportunity to share the gospel to an entire school of children!
