Updated guide explains substance use, risk factors

As part of commemorations of Red Ribbon Week and National Youth Substance Use Prevention Month, our partners at the Drug Enforcement Administration are excited to announce the release of the updated edition of *Growing Up Drug Free: A Parent's Guide to Substance Use Prevention*. The publication was written by the DEA in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Education.

This guide includes an overview of substance use among children and young adults; descriptions of some substances young people may use; a look at risk factors that may make children and young adults try alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs;



and protective factors that help offset those risks, along with suggestions for how to talk to young people about alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs.

This 64-page publication is packed with information and is available at no cost. Every Lodge DAP Chair should have this resource. Although this is not a companion piece to *Awkward Conversations*, our collaborative video which premiered

on November 15, it is a great resource for parents or anyone who deals with youth.

The DAP encourages you to share this resource with your colleagues and community partners. This publication is available on getsmartaboutdrugs.gov/publications.

This year has got to be better than 2021. The directors of the Drug Awareness Program wish the very best to all Elks. As we look forward to the New Year, we thank all Elks who, despite the problems we all faced with COVID-19, worked diligently to make the Elks Drug Awareness Program the largest all-volunteer drug education program in the country.
