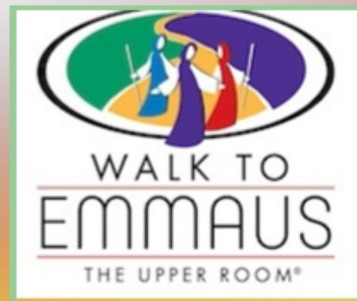

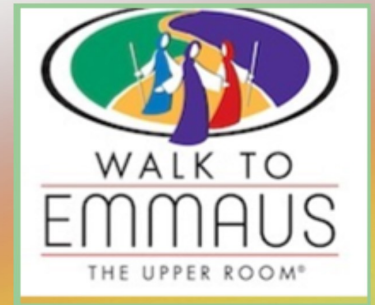

Take a minute and remember your walk. What was the thing that stood out to you about your experience the most? Mine was the love that was shown by the team and community, and I have heard that over and over again.

As a person raised in church, God's love and the love of His people should have never been able to surprise me. I had heard about it nearly all my life. However, there is a big difference between hearing about it and experiencing it. While I truly enjoyed the talks I heard on my walk, nothing changed me nearly as much as the love I experienced. It is what motivated me to listen and challenged me to change.

The Bible has a lot to say about the love we should have for others. This month, I challenge you to be honest with yourself and answer the following questions.

- Would my friends use the love I have for others to identify or describe me?
- How about the person I had the last conflict with? Would they describe me as loving?
- What about strangers that I run into? Would they recognize that I am different?

If the answers to these questions make you feel uncomfortable, today is the day to commit to change. God's love can be shared everywhere! It doesn't just have to be on Emmaus weekends. Imagine what would happen if God's people would show that kind of love every day. Imagine what could happen if you and I would demonstrate that kind of love all the time.

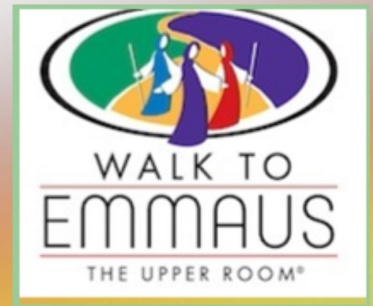

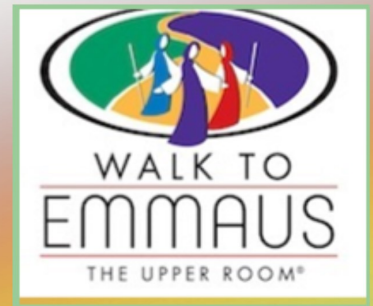
Community Registrars and Sponsorship

Important Walk Reminders

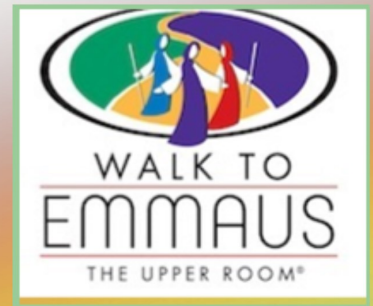
The purpose of Emmaus is to develop Christian disciples and leaders by inspiring, challenging, and equipping active adult church members for Christian action in their homes, churches, workplaces, and communities. It's about the pilgrims!

Please attend Send Off, Candlelight, and Closing. The more community members that are there, the more support the pilgrims feel. Remember to enter the grounds quietly for Candlelight and Closing. Unless you are on the team, these are the only times that you should be on the campground.

In case you didn't know, share groups can help prepare and serve a meal. If your group would like to take care of a meal during the weekend, just let the kitchen coordinator know. You prepare the meal, serve the meal, can help clean up, and then leave. The team and pilgrims greatly appreciate seeing your smiling faces!

Remember only people who have been on an Emmaus Walk or Chrysalis Flight are allowed to attend walk events. No children are allowed out of respect for the pilgrims.
