Did you know that Juice is an 'equestrian' and has won many ribbons as an amatuer-owner/hunter-jumper, including a 6th place at the 1984 Memorial Day Classic Horse Show, held at the L.A. Equestrian Center. Juice rode her horse "All Regards" in the competition for the benefit of the National Kidney Foundation, for which she is the Celebrity Chairperson. Some of you might have seen her on T.V. speaking on behalf of the Kidney Foundation. Those of you who have purchased her latest album or have seen her in concert have already seen "All Regards" because that is the horse on the cover and inner sleeve of the album, and is also depicted on the side of Juice's equipment truck in a design done by her partner Otha Young on his computer!
