



Revisions to the Groundwater Management Plan Rules and Regulations

❖ Quantity Rules and Regulations Revisions Summary

- Added Definitions
 - Chapter 3: Added 25 definitions for clarification of the rules and regulations
- Added Chapter 4: Enforcement of Rules and Regulations
 - Explains the policy and procedures for violations to the rules and regulations
- Chapter 5: Well Permitting Revisions
 - Late Permits now \$1,000.00 (5.5)
 - Replacement wells can only be drilled in the same section as the original well (5.9)
 - Added section for commingled wells (5.13)
 - Test-hole documentation additions (5.14.2.2 – 5.14.2.6):
 - The District must be notified of test-hole drilling 2 full District working days in advance.
 - The District may have a staff member or other third-party representative on site for test-hole drilling.
 - The District may reject test-hole documentation that is not representative of the area geology, is neither true or accurate, or has been falsified.
 - Livestock feeding operations must submit a site plan with a well permit application. (5.14.4)
 - Wells must be drilled to the depth of the test-hole log submitted or to a depth that still meets the minimum score required for approval. (5.18.1)
- Chapter 10: Groundwater Transfers and Conveyance into a structure or stream
 - Revised the wording to clarify the rule
 - Permits are required to pump into a structure or stream (10.15)
 - Flowmeters will be required (7.2.1)
