#### **Pondering Pastor**

Bless the Lord, O my soul.

Praise the Lord!~Psalm 104:35h

The Book of Psalms is one of the most mysterious parts of the Bible. It was not written by one person. Some of the Psalms are very old. No one is really sure when the Book of Psalms came into being. We are not sure what the purpose of all the psalms were. What we do know is that the Book of Psalms existed a century, or two, before Jesus. It is said the Book of Psalms was one of two "best sellers" at the time of Jesus.

Jesus likely knew the Psalms. In three of our gospels, Jesus quotes a psalm at the time of his death. In the Gospel of Matthew and the Gospel of Mark Jesus quotes Psalm 22. In the Gospel of Luke he quotes Psalm 31.

The Book of Psalms contains many types of psalms. Some of these psalms contain the deepest prayers and emotional longing for God that we can find recorded in scripture. It is a book of great variety. There are psalms that tell of creation, the history of God and God's people, and sing praises to God. But there are also psalms that record for us how ancient people worshiped, how individuals complained to God, how the people as a whole complained to God, and how they found wisdom. The collection of Psalms in the Bible is a valuable collection of ancient poetry.

Years ago I was given a CD of people singing some psalms. Listening to it has enriched my worship and spiritual life. This summer we will be hearing the psalms read in worship. We may try to sing a few as well. My hope is that by focusing on the psalms we will find new ways to pray and talk to God. At the very least we will learn more about parts of this ancient book of the Bible. Join us for worship in June when we hear more about the psalms. We will continuing hearing psalms in worship through July as we think about how the Bible shows us how to pray.


#### Labyrinth!

#### **Discretionary Fund**

First Congregational Church is known for helping our neighbors who find themselves in emergency situations. We fill this fund by collecting noisy change the first Sunday of the month, recycling cans, Christmas Eve offering, the Superbowl Board, and usually another fundraiser each year. (In addition to a gift from Broadway Bargains each year.) The fund is low at this time but we have had reduced referrals and we have stopped doing emergency housing in hotels until the weather is cold. Local residents can access this fund once in a six month period, if it is an emergency and funds are available. We continue to appreciate donations to this fund.

#### **Study Leave?**

Did you know that clergy, like most other professionals, are required to do continuing education? In the Rocky Mountain Conference of the UCC, pastors are required to complete 15 hours of education each year. Pastor Kelli will be completing some of these hours during her study leave June 17-20. 
