

Membership retention begins with a welcoming atmosphere in the Lodge. Be sure to reach out to new Members and let them know their presence is appreciated. It's also important to give new Members the chance to be actively involved. Let them know about volunteer opportunities and encourage them to become active in strengthening the Lodge and assisting the community. People who volunteer to help others will usually also find themselves more deeply attached to the Elks.
