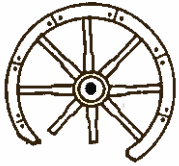


Resolved that the City of Marksville informs the Louisiana Department Of Environmental Quality that the following actions were taken by Town Councilmen.
