# **Burning Restriction Lifted:**

The state burn ban has now been lifted and burning is allowed with a valid Air Quality Management District burn permit. Permits run from January to December. Permit applications are available at the Fire Station/District office. Send completed applications & permit fees to the AQMD office at 707 L Street, Eureka, CA 95501. You may also apply online at http://www.ncuaqmd.org/index.php?page=burn. permits. Your permit will be emailed to you.

Burn day information for Shelter Cove (Zone 1) is available each day by calling 1-866-BURN-DAY. Please have your permit on-site while burning.

### Fire Extinguisher Recharge:

The community may bring their fire extinguishers to the Fire House on the morning of <u>Thursday</u>, <u>December 9<sup>th</sup></u>, for recharging by Eureka-Humboldt Fire Extinguisher, phone 822-2517. The cost of this service will depend on the unit size.

#### Seasonal Reminder:

Please ready your homes and vehicles for the winter season: Clean your chimneys and gutters, make sure your smoke and carbon monoxide alarms have fresh batteries and have emergency supplies close at hand. Slow down when driving as you may have to unexpectedly negotiate hazards such as rocks, fallen trees, and wildlife on the roads.

The cost (fee) of using this service is 2.25% per (self-pay) transaction. Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover Card credit and debit cards are accepted. To complete an online payment, you will need your utility account number (located on the top left, second line of your utility bill) and the service street address. The District's website will also link to Allpaid's website.
