

## OMI MODEL COURSE 1.14 HEALTH FIRST AID

### TECHNICAL FOUNDATION:

Section A-VI/4-1 of the International Convention on Training, Certification and Guarding,

STCW-78, as amended, establishes fundamental First Aid requirements

Health that includes the management of the First Aid Kit and Medical Advice by Radio.

a Merchant Marine Deck Officer is required, management level of each ship major that carries out cabotage navigation of up to seven days close to the coast.

Furthermore, for reasons of safety in navigation and human life at sea, an Officer or Crew Member of Special Vessels is required to have a gross tonnage greater than 50.

### TARGET POPULATION:

Deck Officers of the Merchant Navy, management level who will work on ships adults who carry out cabotage navigation of up to seven days close to the coast. Officer or Crew Member of Special Ships

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Have passed, and have the course 1.13 Basic First Aid current.

### GENERAL OBJECTIVES:

At the end of the course the student will be able to:

1. Efficiently administer first aid to the injured person.
2. Reduce the risk for the injured party.
3. Stabilize the victim's vital functions and prepare them for transfer to the center assistance.
4. Diagnose the probable causes, nature and severity of the patient's injuries.
5. Communicate the diagnosis to the Maritime and Health Authority, in order to facilitate to the specialist the preparation of Emergency Care in a healthcare center.

6. Coordinate, according to the circumstances and according to the diagnosis, a means of rescue that accelerates the care of the injured person.
