

By-Law No. 73-1

A BY LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BLACKS HARBOUR N.B.

RESPECTING THE CORPORATE SEAL

THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BLACKS HARBOUR N.B. DULY
ASSEMBLED HEREBY ENTACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The corporate seal of the municipality is the seal an impression of which is affixed to this by-law.
2. The clerk shall
 - (a) have the custody of the corporate seal; and
 - (b) affix the corporate seal to
 - (i) every agreement, contract, deed or other document to which the municipality is a party and which in order to have any force or effect, requires to be sealed with the corporate seal of the municipality and signed by the mayor and the clerk of the municipality, and
 - (ii) every by-law of the municipality.
3. This by-law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.

READ A THIRD TIME AND DONE AND PASSES IN COUNCIL this 3rd day of
January 1973.
