Sunday, July 19

Rest / meal stops en route *Turn watches back one hour to Central Time*

Monday, July 20

Breakfast included at hotel

Depart Madison

Rest / lunch stops en route

Arrive Sioux Falls, SD – Country Inns & Suites

Evening to explore **Sioux Falls Park** (a public park located in north central Sioux Falls, South Dakota, surrounding the city's falls. Through it runs the Big Sioux River, observation tower, and the remains of an old mill) at your leisure and have dinner (included) at the Falls Landing Restaurant in hotel.

Tuesday, July 21

Breakfast included at hotel

Check out and depart Sioux Falls

Rest / lunch stops en route *Turn watches back one hour to Mountain Time*

Visit the World's Only **Corn Palace** (Some 500,000 tourists come from around the nation each year to see the uniquely designed corn murals. The city's first Corn Palace was built as a way to prove to the world that South Dakota had a healthy agricultural climate), **Wall Drug** (once offering free ice water to attract tourists, it is now a Wild West shopping and entertainment complex), and enjoy the rugged landscape of the **Badlands National Park** (The rugged beauty of the Badlands draws visitors from around the world. These striking geologic deposits contain one of the world's richest fossil beds. Ancient mammals such as the rhino, horse, and saber-toothed cat once roamed here. The park's 244,000 acres protect an expanse of mixed-grass prairie where bison, bighorn sheep, prairie dogs, and black-footed ferrets live today.)

Arrive Rapid City, SD Holiday Inn Express (2 nights)

Dinner on your own (Denny's or Outback near hotel)

Nighttime viewing of **Mount Rushmore National Memorial** for the moving lighting ceremony

Wednesday, July 22

Breakfast included at hotel

Visit **Mount Rushmore National Memorial** (daylight viewing), **Crazy Horse Memorial & Museum** (*helping to preserve the culture, tradition and living heritage of the North American Indians*), & other sights

Fort Hays Chuckwagon Supper and Show is included tonight

Return to our hotel

Thursday, July 23

Breakfast included at hotel

Check out of hotel

Visit **Devil's Tower National Monument** (*the first National Monument, dedicated in 1906 and it stands more than 4 football fields tall*)

Check into the AmericInn Hotel in Cody, WY

Evening to enjoy **Historic Downtown Cody** (*voted the most beautiful small town in Wyoming*) and dinner on your own

Friday, July 24

Breakfast included at hotel

Depart hotel

Meet tour guide at Canyon Lodge, East entrance of **Yellowstone National Park** (*the first National Park*), for tour of lower loop of Park. *The loop tour is a must-do while you are visiting Yellowstone, as it will show you some of the most prominent and incredible sights of the park. You will be shown the Old Faithful area, with a remarkable and a breathtaking view of the cone geyser. This tour will also show you Firehole Lake. This area is filled with hot springs and geysers. Another major point of interest on this tour is Fountain Paint Pot. This is a mud-pot area where the mud is colored red, yellow and brown and surely sounds quite interesting.* Drop Guide and check in at the beautiful Canyon Lodge on the East Side of the park (*evening to relax and enjoy nature*) Dinner included at Canyon Lodge Dining Room

Saturday, July 25

Breakfast included at lodge

Depart Yellowstone through the West Entrance, with a stop at the Norris Geyser Basin Museum and views of the upper loop of Yellowstone.

Check into the Comfort Inn Twin Falls – Jerome, ID

Dinner included at Elevation 486 Restaurant with views overlooking the stunning Snake River Canyon.

Breakfast included at hotel

Today travel to Bend, OR (*with the mighty Deshutes River running through it*) Turn watches back one hour to Pacific Time

Overnight at the Red Lion Deshutes River Hotel

Dinner on own at one of the local restaurants

Monday, July 27

Breakfast included at hotel

Depart following breakfast

Arrive **Crater Lake National Park**

Enjoy a ranger guided tour of the park. *It's the fifth oldest national park in the United States and offers a deep blue lake with amazing cliffs all around. We will enjoy the visitor center and information film as well as the views from the many overlooks.* Lunch on your own in the park.

Depart Crater Lake NP

Arrive Holiday Inn Express, Medford, OR

Dinner included tonight at the Black Bear Diner

Tuesday, July 28

Breakfast included at hotel

Enjoy a tour of the **Headquarters and Flagship Harry & David Factory and Country Village Store** in Medford, OR (*tour includes bakery, candy kitchens and gift packing facilities*)

Lunch stop en route

Arrive Crescent City, CA

Enjoy a visit to **Redwood National / State Parks** (*These trees are the tallest, among the oldest, and one of the most massive tree species on Earth. In addition to the redwood forests, the parks preserve other indigenous flora, fauna, grassland prairie, cultural resources, portions of rivers and other streams, and 37 miles of pristine coastline*), **Battery Point Lighthouse** (*located on a small peninsula which is only accessible during low tide*), and more!

Check into Best Western Plus Northwoods Inn

Dinner on your own this evening at hotel or local restaurant

Wednesday, July 29

Breakfast included at hotel

Trees of Mystery Premier Redwood Attraction (*featuring an unforgettable Sky Trail Gondola ride and interpretive trails through Giant Redwoods, next we will travel the Oregon Coast Highway 101 which is part of the Pacific Coast Scenic Byway. This afternoon we will make several photo / beach stops along one of the most scenic drives in the world.*)

Arrive Coos Bay, OR for our overnight at the Red Lion Coos Bay

Tonight we will enjoy dinner at "Little Italy" (included)

Thursday, July 30

Breakfast included at hotel

Today we will travel North through Oregon with stops including the **Multnomah Falls** (*a 611-foot-tall roaring, awe-inspiring cascade of icy water, lunch included*) and **Columbia River Gorge** (*over 80 miles long and 4000' deep*), before traveling on to our hotel the Red Lion Columbia Center in Kennewick, WA

Dinner on your own this evening

Friday, July 31

Breakfast included at hotel

Depart hotel

Lunch / rest stops en route *Turn watches ahead one hour to Mountain Time*

Check into Hampton Inn, Whitefish, MT, our home for two nights (*Whitefish is a beautiful resort town in the Rocky Mountains of Northwest Montana!*)

Dinner is on your own in the Downtown area with your choice of many restaurants!

Saturday, August 1

Breakfast is included this morning before we depart for a day in **Glacier National Park!** *Glacier National Park is a 1,583-sq.-mi. wilderness area in Montana's Rocky Mountains, with glacier-carved peaks and valleys running to the Canadian border. It's crossed by the mountainous Going-to-the-Sun Road. Our bus will transport us into the park where we will enjoy an 8 hour guided tour of **Glacier National Park** on the famous **Red Bus Tours** - these vintage 1930s buses are part of the human history and heritage of the park. The journey starts in the cedar and hemlock forests of the Lake McDonald Valley. Travel up the Going-to-the-Sun Road along a glacially formed arête to the top of the Crown of the Continent at Logan Pass. Head down through the St. Mary Valley and out to the prairies of Big Sky Country. Continue into the magnificent Swiftcurrent Valley.*

Lunch included at one of the inns

Depart from Park and return to the Hampton Inn

Sunday, August 2

We will depart Whitefish this morning heading toward North Dakota.

Enjoy a visit to Havre, MT and tour of **Havre Beneath the Streets**. *The tour takes us where Havre residents once lived and shopped underground. See the saloon, the meat market, the bordello, and the opium dens. It reopened as an attraction in 1999.*

Depart Havre

Dinner stop at Hinsdale Café (included, cafeteria style)

Check into our hotel in Glasgow, MT

Monday, August 3

Breakfast included at hotel

Depart Glasgow as we travel to Rugby, ND *Turn watches ahead one hour to Central Time*

This afternoon we will visit the **Prairie Village Museum**, (*with its vast collections that span the 1880s through the present, with an emphasis on the turn of the century through the early 1950s. They feature over 15,000 artifacts, including Native American objects, household items, home furnishing and clothing, farm machinery and tools, taxidermy, and vintage cars*) **The Northern Lights Tower**, (*this 88 1/2-foot-tall illuminated steel structure, coated with multi-colored shades of metallic paint, is dedicated to one of Northern Plains' most stunning natural phenomena, the spectacular beauty of the Aurora Borealis*) and **The Geographical Center of North America** Tonight we will stay at the Cobblestone Inn, Rugby, ND and enjoy a dinner buffet at the hotel

Tuesday, August 4

Breakfast included at hotel

Check out and depart for Bloomington, MN

Arrive Fairfield Inn

Evening at the **Mall of America**, *a giant 4 level mall with hundreds of stores plus restaurants, a theme park and aquarium!*

Dinner coupon included for your choice of restaurants within the mall.
