TRUTH QUEST IS ON WEDNESDAYS AT 6:00 PM

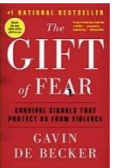
Truth Quest is for preschool through 6th graders. If you have any questions, please contact Pastor Joel.

Daily Devotions for 1 Corinthians 12:12-31

Monday, Aug. 8th - Read Romans 12 and 1 Corinthians 12:12-31 and contemplate their similarities.

Tuesday, Aug. 9th - One of the major themes in 1 Corinthians 12:12-31 is the contrast between how the world relates socially and the way God calls the church to relate socially. Ponder some of those differences.

Wednesday, Aug. 10th - In vs 25-26 Paul tells us the reason why the way we relate to one another is so important. What is that reason? Take some time to reflect on when the church suffered with you and rejoiced alongside you.

Thursday, Aug. 11th - Read vs 27-31 and contemplate how Paul can make a sequential list of spiritual gifts yet urge the Corinthians to see them all as equally important. Also, wrestle with the fact that Paul is urging each believer to embrace their spiritual gift yet, urged them to earnestly desire the higher gifts.

Friday, Aug. 12th - The sum of Paul's teachings concerning the use of spiritual gifts is love for the body. In what ways are you using your spiritual gifts to love and build up the body of Christ?
