As a father doth his children

**In verse 7, he describes how he was gentle as a <u>nursing mother</u>. Now he tells how this was balanced by the instruction of a <u>faithful</u> <u>father</u>:

- a) He <u>welcomed</u> them. *exhorted*
- b) He <u>encouraged</u> them. *comforted*
- c) He <u>instructed</u> them. *charged*

GREAT TRUTHS

1. If you want to influence people for God, you must balance your approach with both *compassion* and *instruction*.

- 2. A father's steady leadership of his children is a clear <u>illustration</u> of all good leadership.
- 3. Balanced leadership produces <u>stable</u> followers.
