# Gaining in Jesus Christ Bible Background: Philippians 3:1-11 Printed Text: Philippians 3:7-11 KJV/NLT Devotional Reading: Matthew 13:44-46

### Aim for Change:

- 1. **DISCOVER** Paul's attitude about the value of knowing Christ Jesus
- 2. **EXAMINE** feelings of achieving honors compared to feelings living a life in Christ.
- 3. **ESTABLISH** a lifelong goal of measuring our achievements against the value of knowing Jesus Christ

### **Devotional Reading:**

- Thursday The Value of the Kingdom Matthew 13:44-46
- 1. What is the kingdom of heaven like? Why? (13:44)
- 2. What happened when the man uncovered the hidden treasure? (13:44)
- 3. To what did Christ compare the kingdom of heaven? Why? (13:45)
- 4. What did the man in the parable find? (13:46)

**Take Away:** Questions you should ask yourself while reading/studying the scripture. It will strengthen your walk with Jesus if you're truly honest with yourself as God already knows.

- 1. Since the Gospel is true and heaven is our destiny, why are we often "ho-hum" about Christ and the Christian life?
- 2. How can we recover the joy and excitement that we had when we first met Christ?
- 3. What first step will you make today to recover the joy of knowing Christ?
- 4. What items do you need to "sell off" in order to follow Christ and His kingdom?

## Bible Background: Philippians 3:1-6

- 1. Why do Christian teachers teach the same things repeatedly? (3:1)
- 2. What happened to Paul when he was eight days old, and what is far more important than this? (3:2-5)
- 3. How well had Paul lived by the law of Moses, and how had he demonstrated his religious zeal before becoming a Christian? (3:6)

#### **Focal Verses:**

- Sunday The Surpassing Value of Knowing Christ Philippians 3:7-11
- 1. How was Paul not boasting, even though he was calling attention to his accomplishments? (3:7-9)
- 2. Why did Paul view his former accomplishments as "rubbish"? (3:8)
- 3. What was Paul's status in Christ? (3:9)
- 4. What longings did Paul admit to the Philippians? (3:10-11)
- 5. What hope did Paul express? (3:11)

**Take Away:** Questions you should ask yourself while reading/studying the scripture. It will strengthen your walk with Jesus if you're truly honest with yourself as God already knows.

- 1. What sorts of things tend to draw you away from Christ?
- 2. How is the Apostle Paul's commitment to Christ an example to you?
- 3. What do you need to start counting as rubbish for the sake of Christ?
- 4. When you face struggles this week, how can you remember to rejoice rather than complain?
