

BY-LAW NO. 94-73

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 79-13, ZONING BY-LAW

BE IT ENACTED by the Village Council of the Village of Blacks Harbour as follows:

The Village of Blacks Harbour Zoning By-Law being By-law numbered 79-13, enacted on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1979, approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 1979 and filed in the Charlotte County Registry Office as number 25 on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 1979, is hereby amended by inserting after the year "1979" in the 4<sup>th</sup> line of Section 7, the following words:
