Other Projects & Activities Completed:

- -An Annual Women's Advent Tea began in 2017.
- -An electronic marquee sign was installed by Summit Avenue.
- -Replacement of three boilers to three energy efficient boilers
- -WiFi was installed throughout our campus.
- -A New Outdoor Creche was custom built for our Nativity Set.
- -A new parish website was launched in 2019.
- -A digital number board was installed in the Church.
- -Through additional restricted donations, we were able to purchase new vestments, hymnals, & Stations of the Cross.
- -Sound system was upgraded in the Church.
- -New Altar Appointments of a Presider's Chair, Deacon's Chair and a side table have been ordered through a bequest left to the parish.
- -Parking Lot lighting was *just* upgraded to LED with daytime/dusk sensors.


