Pony riders will learn how to groom, mount/dismount, sit and balance in a western saddle, use reins to direct, walk, and "whoa." They will also learn basic riding techniques (walking, jogging, and balancing), bathing, feeding, and care of the horses.

Pony Riding Camp is Monday-Friday for 30 minutes per day. There will be 6 children at each camp.
Times: 9:00, 9:45, 10:30, 11:15, 12:45, 1:30, and 2:15.

Required checklist for Pony Riding Camp:

- an equestrian riding helmet (bike helmets are not acceptable)
- riding boots are required to protect their toes from a pony stepping on them – shoes will not be accepted.

For safety reasons, riders who don't have the proper riding boots and helmet will not be allowed to ride and no refund will be given.

If the weather is unsuitable, we will take the children to the barn or gym where they will learn grooming, feeding, and horse care.

Absentees are not eligible for refunds.
