### Devotions for Sept 19-23 1 Corinthians 14:20-28

Sept. 19th - Read verse 20 and reflect on what it means to be an infant and evil, but mature in thinking.

Sept. 20th - Paul alluded to a prophetic warning from Isaiah to Judah to repent and listen to God or they would be judged through captivity to the Babylonians. The foreign language of the Babylonians served as a sign that it's too late to repent and they are now facing God's judgment. Can you reflect on a time in your life when you recognized something as a sign that you should have turned to the Lord in repentance but did not? No, reflect on how His grace rescued you from that situation.

Sept. 21st - Read verses 22 through 25 and think about the importance of clearly conveying the gospel during worship services for the sake of the lost.

Sept. 22nd - Read verses 24 and 25 and reflect on the time when the gospel being preached had that effect on you. That may have been at your conversion or it could've been just a time you were convicted of sin and brought to repentance.

Sept. 23rd - Read verses 26 through 28 and reflect on how important it is that we strive for orderly worship. And, reflect on how you can contribute to the edification of the body of Christ when we gather for worship.
