The 35th NvFRW Biennial Convention was held in Reno on October 18 and 19, 2019. Delegates from SNRW included Bev Anderson, Nancy Brisack, Chris Golightly, Barbara McRoberts, Sally Wiley and club president, Mary Porter.

NvFRW Officers for 2020-21 were elected at the Convention. They include Janet Freixas (President), Caroline Smith (1st V.P.), Barb Hawn (2nd V.P.), Kathy Doyle (Secretary), Lorrie Olson (Treasurer), Rose Fox (Membership Chair), Linda Colavechio (Northern Director) and Michelle Baert (Southern Director).

Also at the Convention it was announced that NvFRW membership for 2019 was 1256, an increase of 108 members. While the club in Laughlin had dissolved in 2019, a new club has been started in Fallon. NFRW membership for 2019 is 54,700. This is an increase of 1,486 women as compared with the 2018 total NFRW membership.

Convention speakers included Senator James Settelmeyer and Assemblyman Al Kramer who presented an overview of the 80th Nevada Legislative Session. Jesus Marquez, prominent Hispanic political analyst and radio broadcaster, and National Republican Committeeman, Lee Hoffman, also addressed the Convention. Congressman Mark Amodei spoke at the dinner following which the newly elected NvFRW officers were installed.
