Why Catholic School?

St. Catherine of Alexandria Parish School Offers:

- **Faith Based Learning**: Students start school in prayer together, attend Mass weekly, and pray for each other daily. Live the faith within their Catholic school and class community.
- **Rigorous Curriculum**: Offers STEM Science pull out classes and labs in middle school with an Accelerated Reader Program for 1st-8th grade students. 85%-90% SCA Students are placed in honors classes in high school due to rigorous learning environment. 75%-80% of SCA graduates choose a STEM field for college major. **Last 10 years SCA has been one of the top three schools in all RIMS Inland Empire as featured in Inland Empire Magazine.**
- **Teach to the Whole Child**: TK-8th grade students not only have rigorous core curriculum classes, but high quality enrichment classes from pull out teachers are offered in **Spanish, Music, Art, Computers, and Physical Education.** Offer daily tutoring and social/emotional support as needed.



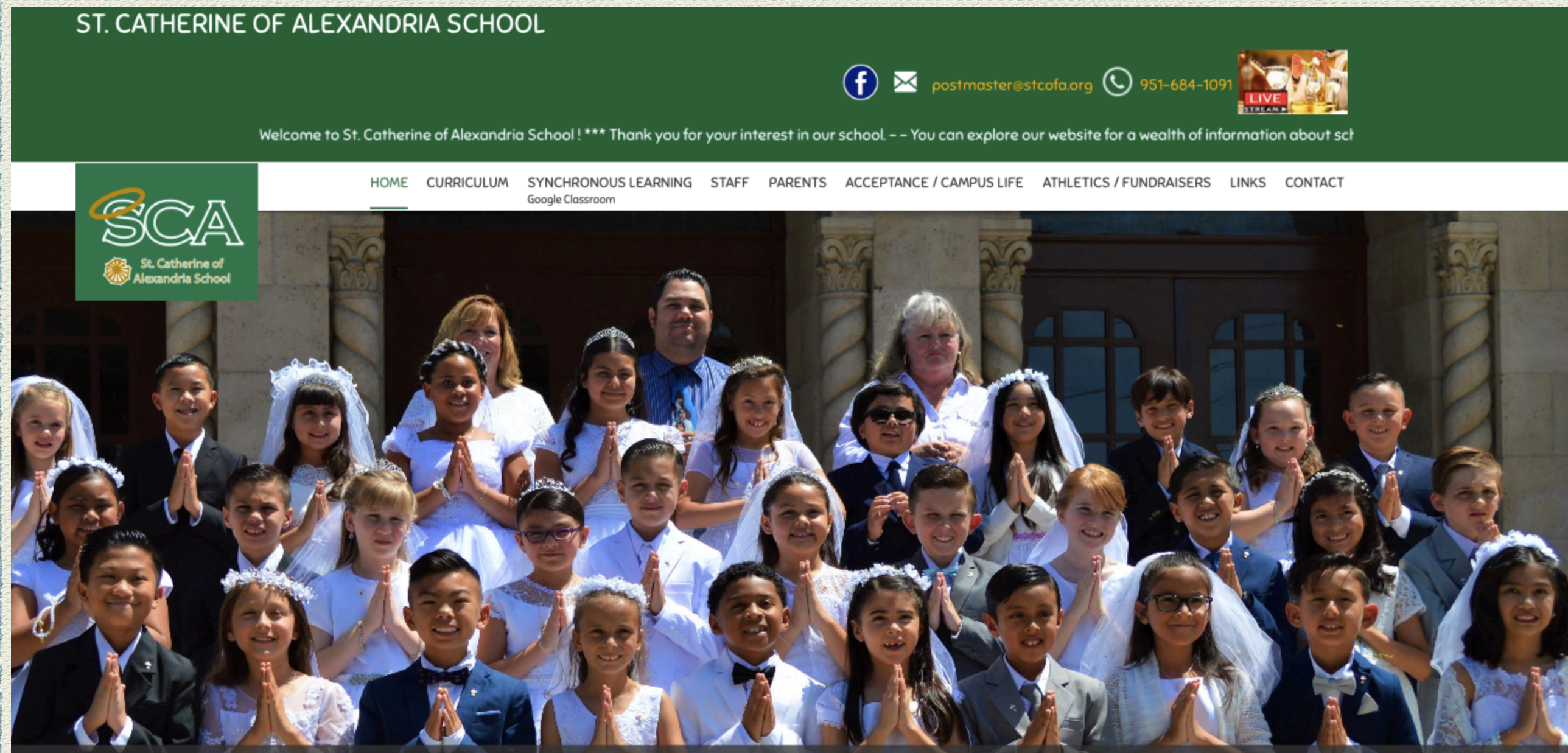
Faith Based Learning

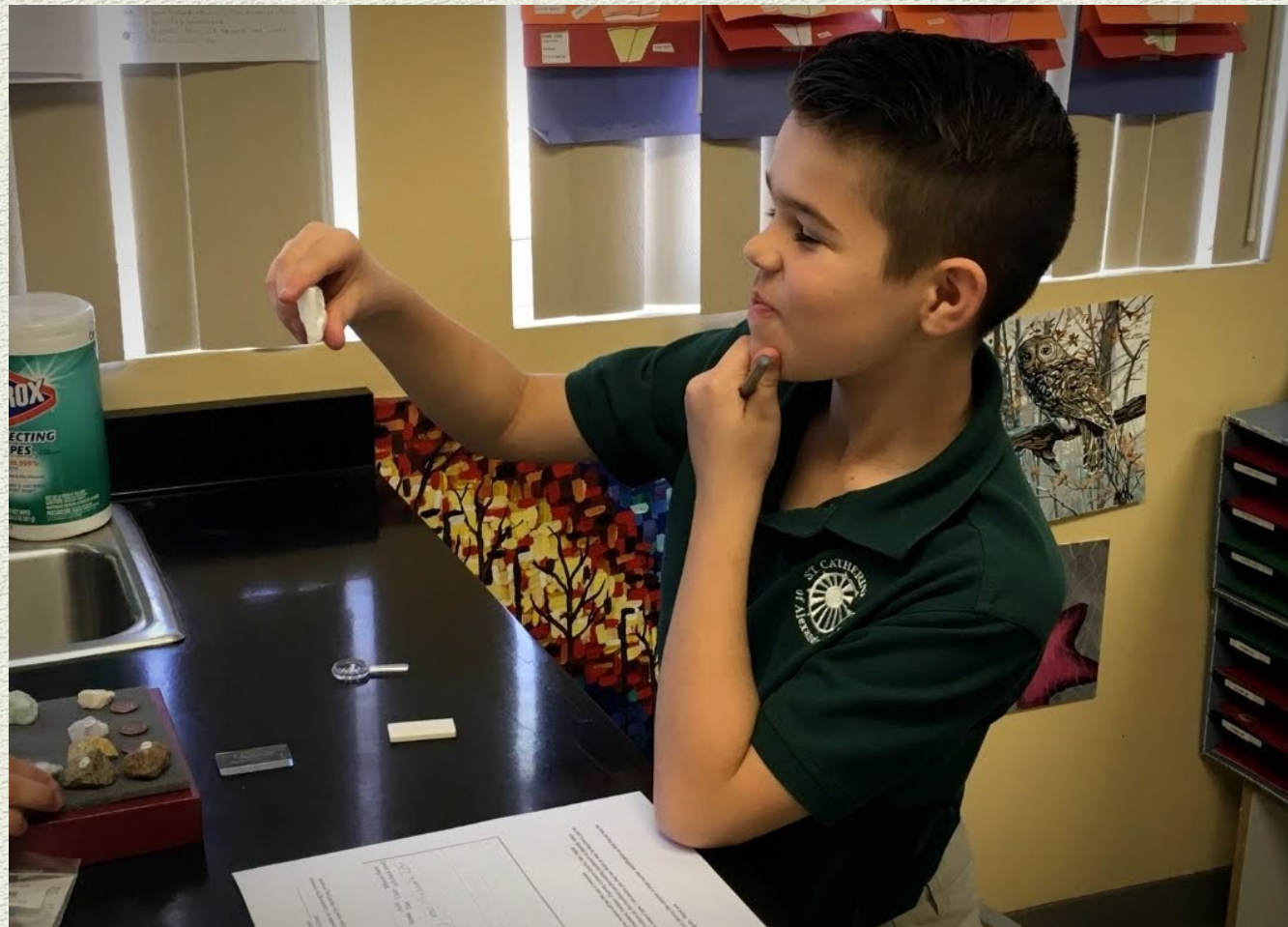
Daily Mass and Religion

Rigorous Instruction: Our School Program



We hope to reopen for on campus instruction very soon, but at this time will be doing **Catholic Online Synchronous Learning**, which is learning in “real time” with your child’s homeroom and elective teachers.

- **Core Classes** from 8:00-12:30 (Religion, Math, Science, Language Arts and Social Studies).
- **Elective Classes** from 1:00-2:30 (Music, Art, Computers, Spanish, PE and Library).
- **Tutoring** offered daily from 2:30-3:15 from both homeroom and elective teachers.
- **Band Instruction** offered bi-weekly for all age groups and 3th-8th grade students have the opportunity to be instructed in Brass, Woodwind and Percussion Instruments.

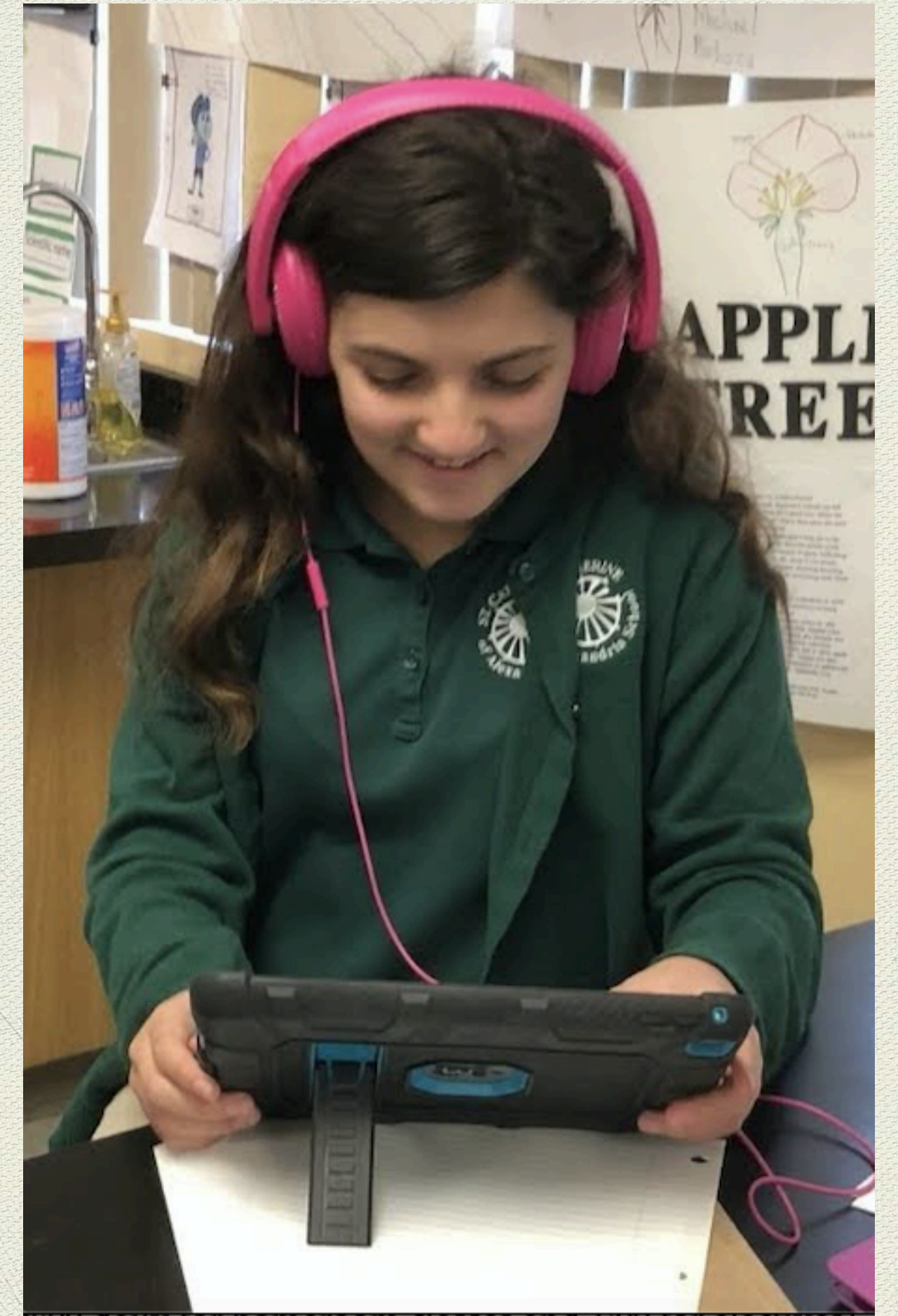

- * An aide will assist the teacher in daily instruction with the students up to 5th grade. Science lab classes are provided in small groups with a virtual pull out class model for grades 6th-8th.
- * **All teachers are available in the afternoon for student tutoring support. Small group and RTI tutoring are also available from 2:30-3:15.**

Reopening Information

The health and safety of students and staff is the top priority when making the decision to reopen school campuses. After 14 day off the watch list, the Diocese of San Bernardino shall follow the CDC guidelines and adhere to California Department of Public Health and California State Department of Education guidelines for the official transition of stages and reopening of Diocesan Catholic Schools.

Our school has a strong reopening plan which enables our classes to be self contained with no exposure between class grade levels:

- Temperature check for all students and staff prior to entering campus
- Strict on campus cleaning procedures
- Face shields provided by the school for TK-2 and all students will have option to purchase is needed.
- Smaller school that allows for social distancing
- Spacing between desks (see classroom setup)
- Lunch and recess self contained classes
- Systematic drop off and pick up procedures
