#### FULL-TIME JOB VACANCIES

##### Industrial Electrician and Instrument Technician:

**Duties:** Installs electrical circuits, relays, switch gear, wiring, electronic alarms, and telemetering equipment used in the operation and monitoring of high voltage distribution systems, emergency power generators, water pumps and telemetry systems. Troubleshoots, programs, and repairs automated control device; repairs, adjusts, and replaces electrical relays, pumps, motors, & pressure control valves.  
**Minimum qualifications:** High school graduate, clean DMV record and previous experience with Community College, technical or other relevant course work. Passing a pre-employment physical and drug screen required.

**Desired qualifications:** 3 to-5 years of journey-level experience in electrical and electronic construction, repair and maintenance, preferably with some direct experience at a water/wastewater treatment plant, hydro-electric plant, or similar facilities.

**Salary & benefits:** Compensation range \$24.55 to \$45.87 based on experience. Benefits package includes health, dental, vision, life insurance and Cal PERS retirement. Application and job description are available at the RID office and website. Vacancy open until filled.

##### Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Grade 2

**Duties:** Responsible for wastewater treatment plant operations, including formulation and implementation of wastewater treatment plant operation and safety methods. Plant monitoring required on weekends

**Minimum Qualifications:** Must possess a valid Grade 2 Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Certificate issued by California SWRCB. Two years of experience working in a wastewater laboratory and wastewater treatment plant operation; Must pass a drug and alcohol screening and physical exam. Must live within one hour traveling time to Shelter Cove.

**Desired Qualifications:** One year of experience in the operation of domestic water treatment and distribution.

**Salary & benefits:** Compensation range \$19.55 to \$40.98 based on experience. Benefits package includes health, dental, vision, life insurance and Cal PERS retirement. Application and job description are available at the RID office and website. Vacancy open until filled.

We will try to keep water outages to a minimum and the time restrictions for performing work will be Monday through Saturday 7:30AM to 6:00PM.

#### GREASE AND TRASH DISPOSAL

The proper way to dispose of fats, cooking oils and grease is to place into a container and dispose of them in the garbage. We have been experiencing serious damage to sewer lift pumps caused by items being flushed down the toilet, so please refrain from using your toilet as a trash basket and avoid using the sewer system to dispose of greasy food scraps. Pouring grease or oil into the sewer pipes can cause the wastewater system to backflow into homes and businesses.
