

Ephesians 4:7 But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift.

I Corinthians 12:4-7 Now there are different gifts, but the same Spirit. There are different ministries, but the same Lord. And there are different activities, but the same God is active in everyone and everything. A manifestation of the Spirit is given to each person to produce what is beneficial.

I Peter 4:10 Based on the gift they have received, everyone should use it to serve others, as good managers of the varied grace of God.

All of us have been given a gift, a spiritual gift. We are instructed to use that gift to serve others. We are to use it "to produce what is beneficial."
