Do you know why cows stick their tongues in their nostrils?

Tiny glands in a cow's nose secrete mucus to protect their lungs from harmful bacteria in the air they breathe. The bacteria gets stuck in the mucus instead of reaching the lungs -which could potentially make the cow sick.

But all this mucus can make for a messy nose!

Since it's tough for cows to blow their nose with a tissue, the cow will curl her long tongue into her nostril to give it a good clean. Cow tongues are perfectly shaped for cleaning their noses. Better yet, their tongues are quite rough, which helps scrape their nostrils clean.
