#### HIGH SURF ADVISORY

During the pacific winter weather cycle, large ocean



swells, generated from southerly storms, impact Shelter Cove's shoreline. People should exercise caution when high surf conditions are present:

Never turn your back on the ocean.

Stay further back from the water than usual, avoiding salt spray.

Stay off the jetty and rocks.

Stay out of the water as sleeper waves and strong rip-tides appear along the coastline.

#### FIRE DEPARTMENT NEWS

##### **Burning Safety Reminders:**

Even though we recently received a small amount of rain, we are still experiencing an unusually dry start to the winter season and we encourage residents to be extra safe with outdoor fires. Please follow directions on your Air Quality Management District (AQMD) fire permit, keep burn piles small and refrain from burning on windy days. Please be aware that our fire department does not set the status of burn days, AQMD determines burn days based solely on air quality and local burning conditions. New AQMD burn permits for 2018 are available at the District Office or from the Fire Department. You may call 1-866-287-6329 to get the burn-day status after 5 p.m. the day before you plan to burn.

##### **Fire Extinguisher Training:**

The Fire Department will be offering free fire extinguisher training to the Shelter Cove community on Saturday, January 27<sup>th</sup> at 9 a.m. at the Fire Station. Registration is not necessary for this event and if you don't have your own fire extinguisher the fire department will provide you with one. For more information please call Sal at 986-7507.
