Brazil: Tim & Betty Hawkins in Manaus

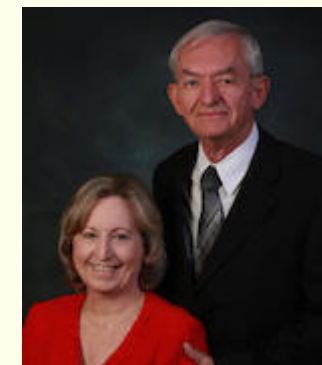

Tim and Betty Hawkins are missionaries in Manaus, the capital and largest city of the state of Amazonas (Brazil has 26 states). Manaus is located in the center of the Amazon rainforest, in Brazil's North Region. The city has a population of over 1 million souls. Bro. Hawkins' parents also were missionaries to this region. Bro. Tim at 11 months old started his life in Brazil; he was saved at the young age of 8 years old. Sis Betty was saved at 17 yrs old.

The Hawkins met each at Massillon Baptist College in Massillon, Ohio, and were married in 1977. Since 1980, they have started churches, worked diligently and when time had come, local, faithful men were led by God to become pastors. Bro. Hawkins has trained over 200 young church leaders & pastors in the Bible Baptist Institute in Manaus.
