Reading 1 Corinthians

For the week of 17-21 - 1 Corinthians 1:10-17
Memorization verse: 17

Monday - v 10 – Paul's appeal 'by the name of the Lord Jesus Christ' is important to us. *Lord* implies obedience, *Jesus* means salvation and *Christ* means 'anointed.' As Lord, you can obey Him because He, as Christ, has filled you with His Spirit and, as Jesus, He is saving you from the power of sin. No wonder Paul said we cannot continue in sin (Ro 6:1-4). Make no excuses for sin today. None whatsoever. You can live the life God has called you to live.

Tuesday – v 11 –James tells us that quarrels are often resourced by selfishness (James 4:1-3). We want things that are not in God's will for us or fight to get what we do not trust God to give us. With whom are you quarreling and why? Pay attention to your conflicts today. Are you striving for God's will in your life, others, the world? Or is it selfishly motivated?

Wednesday – v 12-15 –Paul appeals to the Corinthians 'by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ' to gather them around Jesus and not human personalities. As Paul says, no human was crucified for you and no human can do for you what only Jesus can do for you. Today, read your Bible, let Jesus have the ultimate word in your life and tell others about *him* and what *he* says.

Thursday – v 16-17a – Paul did baptize some people, but his primary purpose was preaching the gospel. What secondary issues in your personal life, marriage, vocation or at Heritage, have you made primary and, in the process, lost what it was you were trying to gain? Today, make Christ central to your home, work, play and church life. After all, the power we need for living is found only in the Gospel.

Friday – v 17 –Paul did not try to convince the Corinthians with eloquent appeals. He simply took them back to Jesus (v 10). Nothing can do what only the cross can do. It alone saves us...in every way. Do you have substitutes for Jesus? Are you relying on a finite, fallen mechanism to do what only God can do? Make your appeals today to Christ and His word. Ask the Holy Spirit to do what only a Tri-une God can do.

6. **It frees you.** 8b - 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24
7. **It includes you.** 9
8. **It is not about you.** 8 – the reveling of our Lord Jesus Christ
