We also had the privilege of an overnight trip without our daughter for the first time since her birth. God has truly been good to us. I'm thankful that He is faithful, even when we are not!

Brielle is doing well physically right now. She is using a lot more vocabulary, and is enjoying mimicking her parents and others! She enjoys songs with motions, and even shouts out "Bible!" at the end of "The B-I-B-L-E." Deputation is tough on our little girl, as there is not a lot of structure in our everyday lives. Please pray for us to be faithful in disciplining her and teaching her.

Our support level has risen to 56%, for which we are so grateful. We are praying that God will provide for many of the churches we have been in recently to support us financially. Over the next two months, we will be in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, and Indiana. I am also going to be the keynote speaker at a missions conference in the Grand Cayman Islands.
