Boating Rules – (check By-Laws & Rules Book for all boating rules)

7. All boats must be registered with the Club Office using your Braidwood Recreation Club membership number. Any boat not registered and not displaying a proper BRC Boat Decal will be picked up and a storage fee imposed.
 8. No speeding by motor boats shall be allowed in those lakes set aside for fishing or bathing purposes.
 9. All boats used or kept at the Club shall be the full responsibility of the respective owners.
 10. No sail boats, houseboats, speed boats, skiffs, surf boards or rubber rafts will be allowed in the Braidwood Recreation Club. (The lifeguards will use surf boards at the beach only.) As of 3/15/17 Kayaks allowed on any lake, paddle boats on Beach Lake only, all boating rules apply.
- A-2. ALL boats and trailers must be removed from Club property by the 15th of November. Any boats or boat trailers not taken home by the 15th of November will become Club property.

PONTOON BOAT RULES – 3/14/07

- 1) Maximum length of 24'
- 2) Motor size maximum 9.9 HP
- 3) Pontoon boats are only allowed in Moose, Beach, Beaver, and Goose Lakes
- 4) Proof of Insurance must be provided at time of decal purchase
- 5) State registration (if applicable) and Club decal required
- 6) No excessive noise between sunset and 10:00 A.M.
- 7) All pontoons must be occupied unless parked by the Member's campsite
- 8) Membership # must be displayed in 2" numbers on pontoon
- 9) All State and Club boating rules apply
- 10) Beach Lake has a **no wake zone** in front of the Beach
