

<u>UPDATE ON SOUL WINNING:</u> This year has already started with fruit, and we are so very thankful for it! Three people have trusted Jesus Christ as their Saviour since our last letter. One of them is very special to me as he is my first convert here in Ireland. A man named Mmoloki contacted Pastor Ledbetter. Dan Eberly, another missionary working with Pastor Ledbetter, set up a meeting with Mmoloki, and we had an opportunity to talk to him about the Gospel. He was eager to hear what the Bible said, and he accepted Christ right in the midst of a busy coffee shop! Mmoloki is from Botswana and is in Ireland studying at the Cork University. He has been coming faithfully every Sunday morning, most Sunday evenings, and to the Bible Study on Wednesday. I have started discipling him with a great discipleship course that Pastor Ledbetter has written. Mmoloki has such a hunger to learn about God! Please pray that he will continue to grow spiritually and that I will have wisdom as we go through the course.
