**Saint Januarius** a bishop of Benevento, Italy, who perished with his six companions during the Diocletian persecution in the year 305. He is patron saint of Naples, Italy, and Little Italy, New York; in New York he is remembered at the yearly festival of San Gennaro. MAGNIFICAT

**Saint Andrew Kim** was born in Seoul, Korea. Korean Church arose in the late 18th century after Korean diplomats heard Christ preached by the Jesuits in China and brought Christian tracts home to share with their families and neighbors. Saint Andrew was the first Korean native to be ordained to the priesthood. He was tortured and beheaded along with his lay associate, seminarian **Saint Paul Chöng**. Between 1839 and 1867, 103 martyrs gave their lives for the faith in Korea and they were canonized by Pope John Paul II when he visited Korea in 1988. MAGNIFICAT

**Saint Matthew** one of the Twelve Apostles and author of the first Gospel. Jesus called him as he sat collecting taxes at Capernaum; he is identified with Levi, mentioned in the Gospels of Mark and Luke; in art, he is symbolized by the winged man, one of the four mystical creatures from the Book of Revelation.



**Saint Pius (Padre Pio)** He was born in 1887 in Pietrelcina, Italy; he was a Franciscan Capuchin priest; renowned as a stigmatist, receiving the visible wounds of Christ in 1918; for fifty years he carried on his priestly ministry at San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy; he died in 1968, and was canonized in 2002

**Brothers and Sisters,**

On this 25<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time we celebrate Catechetical Sunday and give thanks for those who teach the faith to others. On this special Sunday may they know the value of what they do. Today's readings show us that holiness and justice go hand in hand. Acting justly towards those who are poor and doing justice in our day-to-day lives are not options. They are an integral part of what it means to be a person of faith, serving the God who is the source of all justice and compassion.



Our first reading introduces us to one of scripture's most vocal prophets on social justice, Amos. Amos set his sights on the social injustice that ran rampant in Israel. Amos was known for his harsh tone and earthly imagery as well as his preaching. He purposefully turned inside-out the beliefs of the self-righteous wealthy Israelites. Amos assured them their treatment of the poor would be their ruin. These self-righteous Israelites claimed a special immunity because God brought them out of Egypt, but Amos retorted that this privilege only made them all the more culpable after they wasted God's special treatment. In our second reading from his First letter to Timothy, Paul says "prayer is essential", not only in individual terms but as the obligation of the whole community. It is important for the common good that we take our responsibility to pray seriously, even when we cannot see the results.

In today's gospel Jesus teaches his disciples an important lesson about wealth. Stewards made a living by collecting rents and debts for their masters and charging the debtors interest on the amount owed, which would then go to the steward's coffers. Here the steward is shameless in the lengths he will go to maintain his position. The steward's behavior in achieving his end calls attention to Jesus' lesson. Anyone of us would go to great lengths, no matter how unsavory, to ensure a secure place in this world, so here is my question to you: How much more should we devote our attention to the world to come? Jesus concludes this parable in verse 13 with the words, "No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon." A Greek translation of the Aramaic word "mammon" means more than wealth and riches, it can signify anything of this world that one relies on: titles, positions, privileges and honors. The true definition of mammon is anything which takes our attention away from God, the true secret of life. It is rare for anyone to be satisfied that they have enough money. The need to be secure can blind us to the needs of others and to the gospel imperative to do justice to those who are poor. The mystic Julian of Norwich tells us that God notices not only great deeds, but also those that are small and simple, because not even the least of our good deeds will be forgotten. Pope Francis teaches us that God invites us to "touch the suffering flesh of Christ in others." If we want to come close to Jesus, the nearest way is through our suffering sisters and brothers.



**San Jenaro**, obispo de Benevento, Italia, que pereció con sus seis compañeros durante la persecución de Diocleciano en el año 305. Es patrón de Nápoles, Italia, y de Little Italy, Nueva York; en Nueva York se le recuerda en la fiesta anual de San Jenaro. MAGNIFICAT

**San Andrés Kim** nació en Seúl, Corea. La Iglesia coreana surgió a finales del siglo XVIII después de que los diplomáticos coreanos escucharan la predicación de Cristo por parte de los jesuitas en China y llevaran folletos cristianos a casa para compartirlos con sus familias y vecinos. San Andrés fue el primer coreano en ser ordenado sacerdote. Fue torturado y decapitado junto con su socio laico, el seminarista **San Pablo Chöng**. Entre 1839 y 1867, 103 mártires dieron su vida por la fe en Corea y fueron canonizados por el Papa Juan Pablo II cuando visitó Corea en 1988. MAGNIFICAT

**San Mateo**, uno de los Doce Apóstoles y autor del primer Evangelio. Jesús lo llamó cuando se sentaba a recaudar impuestos en Cafarnaúm; se le identifica con Leví, mencionado en los Evangelios de Marcos y Lucas; en el arte, está simbolizado por el hombre alado, una de las cuatro criaturas místicas del Apocalipsis.



San Pío (Padre Pío) Nació en 1887 en Pietrelcina, Italia; fue sacerdote capuchino franciscano; reconocido como estigmatizador, recibió las llagas visibles de Cristo en 1918; durante cincuenta años ejerció su ministerio sacerdotal en San Giovanni Rotondo, Italia; murió en 1968, y fue canonizado en 2002.






