Reading 1 Corinthians

Jan 24 - 28 - 1 Corinthians 1:18-25

Memorization Verse: 18

Monday - v 18 - Why does the cross appear foolishness to unsaved people? How is it God's power to us? How are you experiencing the power of the cross in your life?

Tuesday – v 19-21 – How does the cross counter the wisdom of those who think they're wise? How do you choose faith during a crisis that makes you want to look for reasons? Where do you need to apply faith in your life today?

Wednesday – v 21 – How, in the OT, did people try to know God apart from faith? How do people try to get to God in our world? How did God save you? How might your own experience direct your prayers for others?

Thursday – v 22-23 – Why do people demand signs to believe? What signs do modern people look for to have faith? How is the cross a stumbling block to unbelievers? Are you demanding anything from God right now or are you exercising faith in Him?

Friday – vs 24-25 – How is Jesus God's power? How is Jesus God's wisdom? How is Jesus making a difference in your life today? Look for an opportunity to share that news.

Family Quarrels I Corinthians 1:10-18

James 4:1 - *What causes quarrels and what causes fights among you? Is it not this, that your passions are at war within you?*

First: The Basis of Paul's Appeal. v 10a

Second: Paul's Appeal. v 10b

Third: The Reason for Paul's Appeal. v 11-12

Acts 18:24-28

Fourth: The Answer to the Division. 13-18

- a) Christ is not divided –
1 Corinthians 12:12-13
- b) Paul was not crucified –
2 Corinthians 5:14-15 & 19
- c) We are baptized only in Jesus's name
Because only Jesus is crucified for us, we can only be baptized into Jesus.

Fifth: A Word about Jesus

1 Corinthians 1:19-20 - *For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell,²⁰ and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.*

The theme of the Bible is God reconciling all things to Himself in Jesus Christ. Jesus is the great Reconciler. Satan is the great divider.

Conclusion:

The church is supposed to re-present, represent Jesus, who is a Reconciler. If you are dividing, you are acting like the devil.
