## I THESSALONIANS

Part Twenty: "How Can Satan Hinder A Believer?"

I Thessalonians 2:18

Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; but Satan hindered us.

## Paul's Effort To Visit The People

1) Paul's effort was <u>planned</u>; it was based on good <u>intentions</u>.

Wherefore we would have come unto you

- 2) Paul's effort was personal; he wanted to come himself. even I Paul
- 3) Paul's effort was persistent; he did not give up. once and again
- 4) Paul's effort was prevented; Satan stopped him. but Satan hindered us
  - ➔ If Satan could prevent the <u>Apostle Paul</u> from doing good things, he can certainly prevent <u>you</u> and <u>me</u> from doing good things!

→ Satan will try to hinder <u>every</u> effort we make for God.

## Satan Can Only Succeed At Hindering You:

- 1) If you fail to pray.
- 2) If you fail to obey.
- 3) If you stop trying.

4) If God does not want you to go in that direction.
