# MHS COVID PROCEDURES

**THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT ANY TIME**

## General /Horse Show Grounds:

FACE MASKS MUST BE WORN BY ALL PARTIES AT ALL TIMES WHEN UNMOUNTED AND WITHIN A 6-FOOT DISTANCE TO ONE ANOTHER WHEN ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

Anyone entering the show grounds both on competition days and schooling days will be subject to a temperature check. Anyone with a temperature above 99.5 will not be permitted on the show grounds.

Hand sanitizer will be provided around the show grounds, please maintain regular hand washing and had sanitizing practices.

Please be courteous and maintain a 6-foot social distance at all time (this is equivalent to a landing or take off to a jump... or two people steps)

Unless you are a Memory's Hill employee, client, or are stabled overnight, please do not enter the barn for any reason.

The office can be accessed through the main entrance only.

The outside wash stall is available to exhibitors only.

The bathroom in the barn is off limits to guests. Porta Johns and hand washing stations will be available next to the schooling area.

Concessions WILL NOT be provided on the show grounds. Please arrive equipped with sufficient food and water.

Exhibitors may arrive no earlier than 1 hour prior to the start of their class and must depart from the show grounds no later than 1 hour after the conclusion of their last class.

We request that exhibitors exercise extreme caution when inviting friends, family and other guests to spectate. Please respect that for the time being we are attempting to reduce unnecessary traffic as we resume competition in our sport.

## ENTRIES/SHOW OFFICE:

MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN IN THE SHOW OFFICE

One Representative per barn will be allowed into the horse show office prior to the competition to leave open checks and receive back numbers, and after the competition to close the entries.

No more than one exhibitor/trainer may enter the show office at any time.

The horse show office must be accessed through the front door of the barn only

Please wait in line outside the show office, maintaining a 6-foot social distance—that would be equivalent to the take off or landing to a jump

All horses must be pre-entered ONLINE 2 days prior to the start of competition.

PAPER ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

**Back numbers must be kept and used throughout the entire Memory's Hill Series**

All exhibitors must sign the WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT prior to receiving back numbers. This will be part of the online entry

Add/Scratching may be done online up until 6:00 AM on the day of competition

If you need to scratch, please be sure to do it online as to maintain the accuracy of the posted order. Entries that are not scratched online 24 hours prior to the start of competition will be assessed a \$50 scratch fee.

## Checking in/Order of go/In-Gate:

MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN IN THE IN-GATE AREA UNLESS MOUNTED

Social distancing of 6-feet must be maintained at all times (again—same as landing or take off distance to a jump)

There will be posted orders of go issued the day prior to competition. They can be found on [horseshowsonline.com](http://horseshowsonline.com) and on the Memory's Hill Horse Shows Facebook page. Posted orders can also be found with the course charts.

The In-gate area will be restricted to riders, trainers, and grooms only.

Loitering will not be permitted in the in-gate area.

We ask trainers and exhibitors to be conscious of the schedule and ensure that they arrive with their riders to the ring on time so that we can maintain the schedule throughout the day to the best of our ability for all our exhibitors.

## Schooling Area:

MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN IN THE SCHOOLING AREA UNLESS MOUNTED

Social distancing of 6-feet must be maintained at all times (again—same as landing or take off distance to a jump)

Riders, Trainers and grooms only are permitted in this area.

Only the next 5 horses in the order will be allowed in the schooling area at any given time.

2 people per jump are allowed in the schooling area at any give time—that is a total of 4 people

Hand sanitizer must be used prior to jump adjustment and at the completion of jump adjustment. Hand sanitizer will be provided for you at the entrance to the schooling area

Schooling will be available the day before the show in a ticketed style format from 12:00 to 7:00 PM.

### **ENTRIES:**

All exhibitors must provide the show office with a current negative coggins report for each horse brought on the show grounds. Entry form must be filled out completely, including all signatures, and must be accompanied by an open check before back numbers may be picked up. Online Entries are required via [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com). Please pre-enter by the **THURSDAY** prior to the horse show.

### **SCHOOLING:**

Schooling will be permitted after 12:00 noon and until 7:00 PM the day before the show. Flatwork Only will also be available prior to the start of the show on the day of competition as determined by the course designer.

**COGGINS:** All exhibitors must provide the show office with a current negative coggins report for each horse brought onto the show grounds, regardless if they are showing. If the horse is showing, the coggins must be shown prior to picking up back number.

### **STABLING:**

Limited stabling is available. Stalls will be pre-bedded. Stall orders must be pre-paid by noon the Monday prior to the show. Stalls may be paid for by open check or Credit Card information. Please call or text your stall order in to **Tara Deckel (508-776-9247) by 12 PM, noon by the Monday prior to the show. Stall Fees must be paid for at time of reservation by open check or credit card.** Please note stall fees are per DAY not per night.

### **AWARDS:**

Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each division.

## CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

**NOVICE CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER** (SWVHJA & VHSA)-  
Open to children and adult amateurs in their first or second year of showing in jumper  
classes at 0.75m or higher as of December 1st of the current competition year. Riders in  
this division may only cross enter into Novice Jumper, if eligible, and Low Jumper at  
the same show. This division shall be no lower than 0.70m and no higher than 0.75m.  
All classes should be offered under Table IV. If holding a VHSA Association show, the  
VHSA division names must be used on the results.

**LOW JUMPER** (SWVHJA & VHSA) – This division shall be no lower than 0.75m in  
height and no greater than 0.90m in height. Spreads shall be no greater than the height  
of the fence. All classes should be offered under Table IV. If holding a VHSA  
Association show, the VHSA division names must be used on the results.

**CHILDREN'S / ADULT JUMPER** (SWVHJA & VHSA) – Open to horses or ponies  
ridden by a junior or adult amateur exhibitor. Fences .95 to 1.05 meters. USEF Tables I  
– IV may be used.

**SCHOOLING JUMPER?LEVEL 2 JUMPER** (SWVHJA & VHSA) – Fences .95 –  
1.0 meters. USEF Tables I – IV may be used.

**LEVEL 3 JUMPER** (SWVHJA) – Fences over 1.0 – 1.10 meters. USEF Tables I – IV  
may be used.

**MODIFIED?LEVEL 4 JUMPER** (SWVHJA & VHSA) – Fences over 1.10 – 1.20  
meters. USEF Tables I – IV may be used.

**LEVEL 5 JUMPER** (SWVHJA) – Fences over 1.20 meters. USEF Tables I – IV may  
be used.

**VHSA ASSOCIATE THOROUGHBRED JUMPER** (VHSA)- The VHSA Associate  
Thoroughbred Jumper Division is limited to horses who are registered with or are  
eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. In order to accrue VHSA Associate  
points the height for this division the jump/fence heights in each class shall be no lower  
than 2'6" and no higher than 3'0". Spreads shall be no greater than height of the fence.  
The VHSA Associate Thoroughbred Jumper Division may not be combined with any  
other VHSA Associate recognized division with the exception of the Low Jumpers  
when necessary. Horses must be registered with the VHSA and owners must be current  
VHSA members in order to accrue points towards VHSA Associate year-end awards.

**VHSA PONY EQUITATION MEDAL CLASS:** Open to Junior Members of the  
VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday. Rider must be a member of VHSA  
prior to entry in the class. To be ridden on ponies over a course of not less than 6  
obstacles; 2'3" for ponies not exceeding 12.2 hands, 2'6" for ponies over 12.2 hands and  
not exceeding 13.2 hands, and ponies over 13.2 hands not exceeding 14.2 hands jump  
2'9"-3'. Jumping fault soft mount no to count. Fall of pony or rider or three  
disobediences shall eliminate a contender. Entrants in this class may not compete in the  
VHSA Hunter Seat Medal Class at the same show. There must be at least three (3)  
exhibitors to fill the class and three (3) exhibitors must complete the course in order for  
that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. The VHSA Pony Medal may run  
concurrently with the small, medium and large pony division, and may be combined  
with the MHS A Pony Medal Class. Test must be included in the original course. At the  
Finals, the judge must test at least the top 4 over fences.

## CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

**ADULT EQUITATION ON THE FLAT** - Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the flat. Riders must stay within their age group if classes are split by age.

**JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 14 & Under** - Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17 and/or the Adult Equitation on the flat.

**JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 15-17** - Open to riders who have reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year, but not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & under and/or the Adult Equitation on the flat.

**VHSA CHILDREN'S PONY MEDAL CLASS:** Open to junior members of the VHSA who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. Testing must be included in the course. Open to ponies only. Small and medium ponies to jump 2'0". Large ponies to jump 2'6". Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 2'6" at the same show. There will be no additional test for this class. The VHSA Children's Pony Medal may run concurrently with the small, medium and large children's pony division, and may be combined with the MHSA Children's Pony Medal Class. There must be at least (3) exhibitors to fill the class. Six ribbons. In the Finals, the judge must test at least the top 4 over fences. The top 20 point earners qualify for the finals to be held at The Warrenton Pony Show.

**VHSA CHILDREN'S MEDAL CLASS:** Open to Junior members of VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday. Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3 feet, 3 inches (1.0m) with the exception of the Childrens/Adult Jumper division, at the same show, where a rider may not jump higher than 3'9" (1.15m). Rider must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. Open to horses only. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. This also applies to the show hosting the VHSA Adult/Children's Hunter Medal Finals. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing over fences. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. There must be at least three (3) exhibitors to fill the class and three (3) exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Medal can be combined with the VHSA Adult Medal. In the Finals, same testing applies.

**VHSA ADULT AMATEUR MEDAL CLASS:** Open to horses only. Rider must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3, and must hold a current amateur card issued by USEF. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3 feet, 3 inches (1.0m) with the exception of the Childrens/Adult Jumper division, at the same show, where a rider may not jump higher than 3'9" (1.15m). This also applies to the show hosting the VHSA Adult/Children's Hunter Medal Finals. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing over fences. Jumping faults of mount not to count. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. There must be at least three (3) exhibitors to fill the class and three (3) exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Class can be combined with the VHSA Children's Medal. In the Finals, same testing applies.

## CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

**SWVHJA ADULT MEDAL** - Same specs as for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal Class, except open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Ponies may be ridden by adults, but may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Hunter Seat Medal. SWVHJA Adult Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Adult Medal Finals.

**SWVHJA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL** - Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3' that must include two changes of direction, a combination and at least three oxers. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. Same horse must be used for both phases. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points during the show year. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Adult Medal. SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Hunter Seat Medal Finals.

**SWVHJA PONY MEDAL** - Open to current junior members of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. A minimum of six riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. The same pony must be used for both phases. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If no Pony Medal is offered, a rider may compete on a pony in the Hunter Seat Medal. A rider cannot compete in both the Pony and the Hunter Seat Medals in one show, nor can they participate in both aforementioned finals in one year. SWVHJA Pony Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Pony Medal Finals.

**HOLLINS MEDAL**— Open to junior and adult amateur riders who have not qualified for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal, SWVHJA Adult Medal, or the Oakridge Medal during the existing or previous year; qualifiers for the SWVHJA Pony medal are still eligible. The class will consist of 2 phases, each counting for 50% of the total score. First phase shall be shown over a course of fences and will not contain a combination. The second phase will be a flat phase, shown at the walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. The same horse must be used for both phases. Martingales are permitted in the flat phase.

**SWEET BRIAR COLLEGE MEDAL**— Open to juniors and amateurs. To be shown over a course of no less than 6 jumps at 2'9". Course must include 2 changes of direction, and may contain an in and out. The judge will then have the option of testing the top 4 riders. Tests 1-10 may be used. The same horse must be used in both phases. Three competitors must complete the course for points to count. Riders may not have shows in a 3'6" or higher Equitation medal class, and may not jump higher than 2'9" at the same show. This class may be combined with other classes of similar specifications. This class is not recognized or sanctioned by SWVHJA. Finals will be held at the Sweet Briar College Winter Horse Show in December. To qualify for the finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points, or be in the top 15 point earners for the year. Riders may continue to compete throughout the year.
