I'm extremely excited to begin another school year here at SCA and can't wait to get started!












Let SCA Meet Your Child's Individual Learning Needs

* Morning Mass is live-streamed and recorded for later family viewing. Mass link located on the St. Catherine of Alexandria website.








Students will have an understanding of the following:

- 5. Advanced: (fives and tens, even and odd numbers)









- Seasonal art projects are also explored in art class for each grade.































Safety for Kindergarten





Before you begin school we will have a meeting to review the details for the your class:

- Option of later drop off (Can drop off between 7:30-8:00 or have the option of 8:00-8:15 at the gate)
- Option of early pick up (2:15 at gate but can also pick up at normal dismissal at 3:00)
- Snack is provided at during school time
- Aftercare available (3:30-6:00)
- Classroom environment: sterilized daily after school.
- Social distancing (all desks spaced)
- TK/Kindergarten class restroom (cleaned throughout the day)
- Touchless dispensers
- Playground cleaned after each use
- Lunch tables cleaned and spaced
- Mask to be worn while we are on Purple/Red (new CDPH guidelines)



SCA School Uniforms





Fees due at time of registration:

Registration/Student Fee: \$350 per child if PAID by June 1, 2021 (Non-Refundable)

\$400 per child if PAID after June 1, 2021 (Non-Refundable)

Technology Fee: \$100 per child (Non-Refundable)

Graduation Fee: (8th Grade ONLY): \$100.00 per student

Other Tuition Requirements:




