

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
CITY OF PATTON VILLAGE
TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM
WATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT 7215369**

The City of Patton Village will conduct a Close Out Public Hearing to discuss the activities accomplished during the implementation of a Texas Department of Agriculture Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG)-funded Water Project under Contract No. 7215369. At the Hearing, citizens will have the opportunity to discuss the actual accomplishments of the grant funded activities at City of Patton Village's Popham Street Water Plant #2. The project included the following construction improvements: rehabilitated existing ground storage tank, installation of new (250 gpm) booster pumps, chlorination system, new site fencing, new water equipment building, yard piping, new electrical and controls. In addition, the project included installation of a new hydro pneumatic pressure tank, grading and drainage improvements and associated appurtenances.

In addition, the City's participation in Affirmative Action and Equal Opportunity will be discussed. At this time the City of Patton Village will also present information regarding the National Fair Housing Act and will discuss ways to implement Fair Housing within the City.

The Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, the 5th day of December 2019 at 6:00 PM in the Council Chambers of the Patton Village City's Court Annex Building located at 16940 Main Street, Splendora ,TX 77372. All citizens and interested parties are encouraged to attend. Interested citizens who are not able to attend the Public Hearing may submit their written comments to the office of the Mayor, at City Hall, 16940 Main Street, Splendora ,TX 77372.
